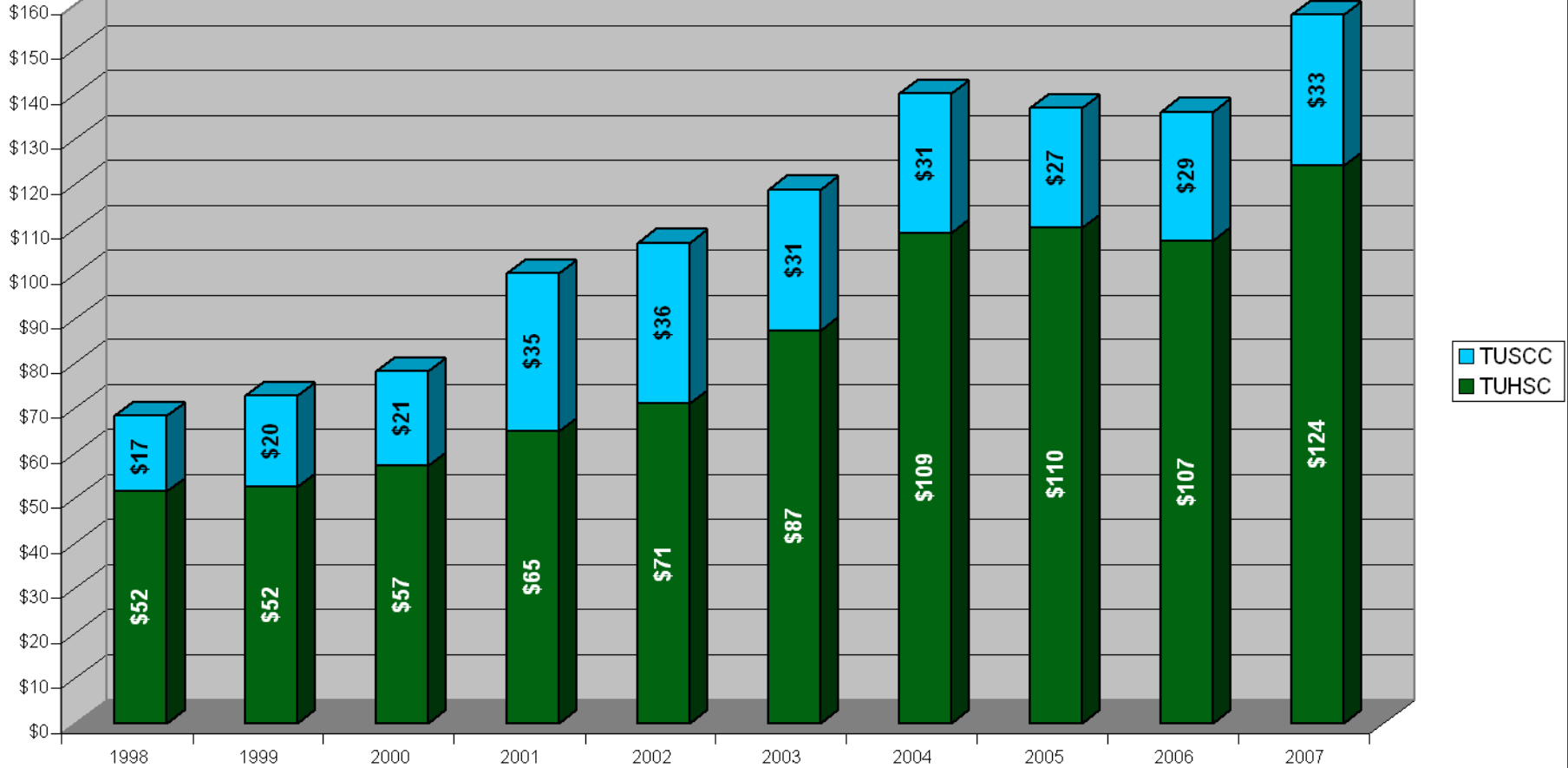

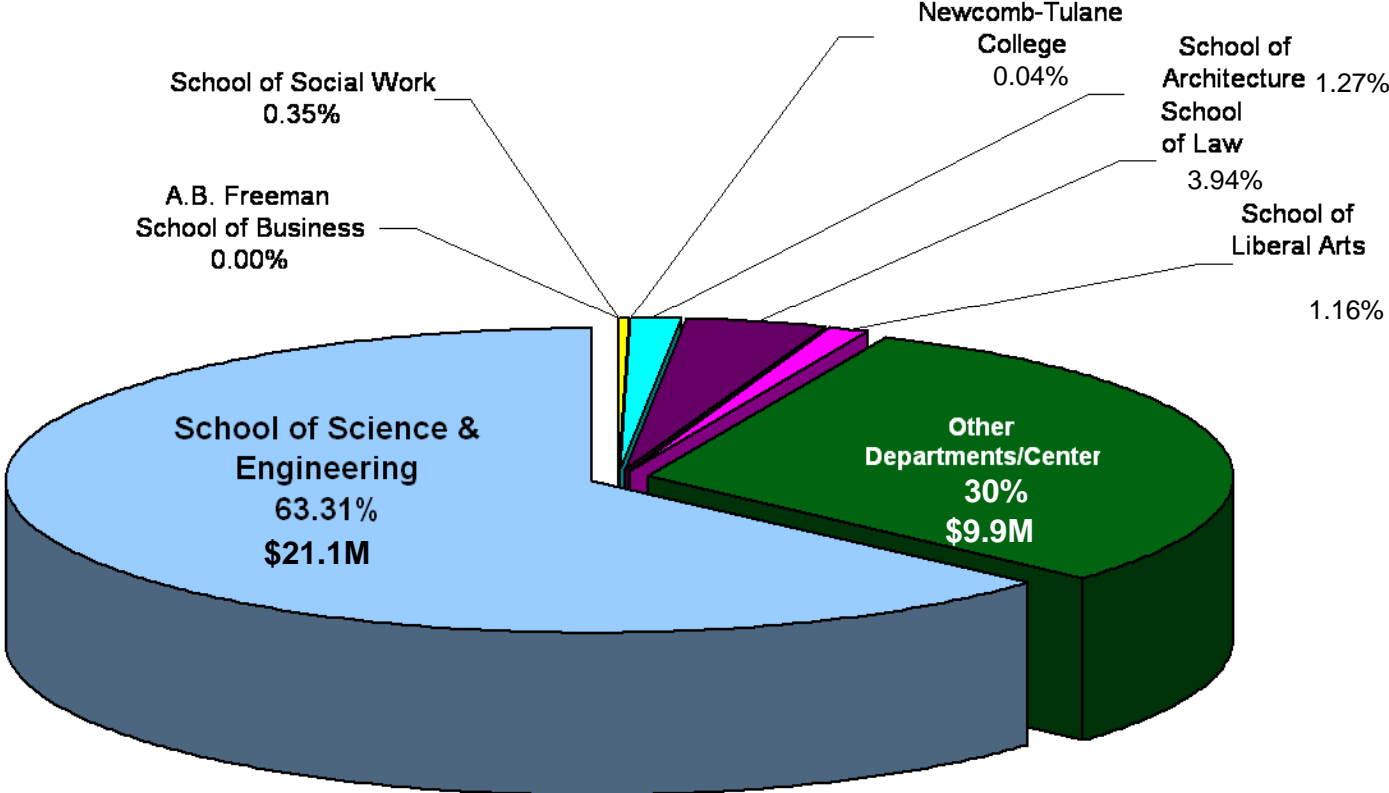

Millions

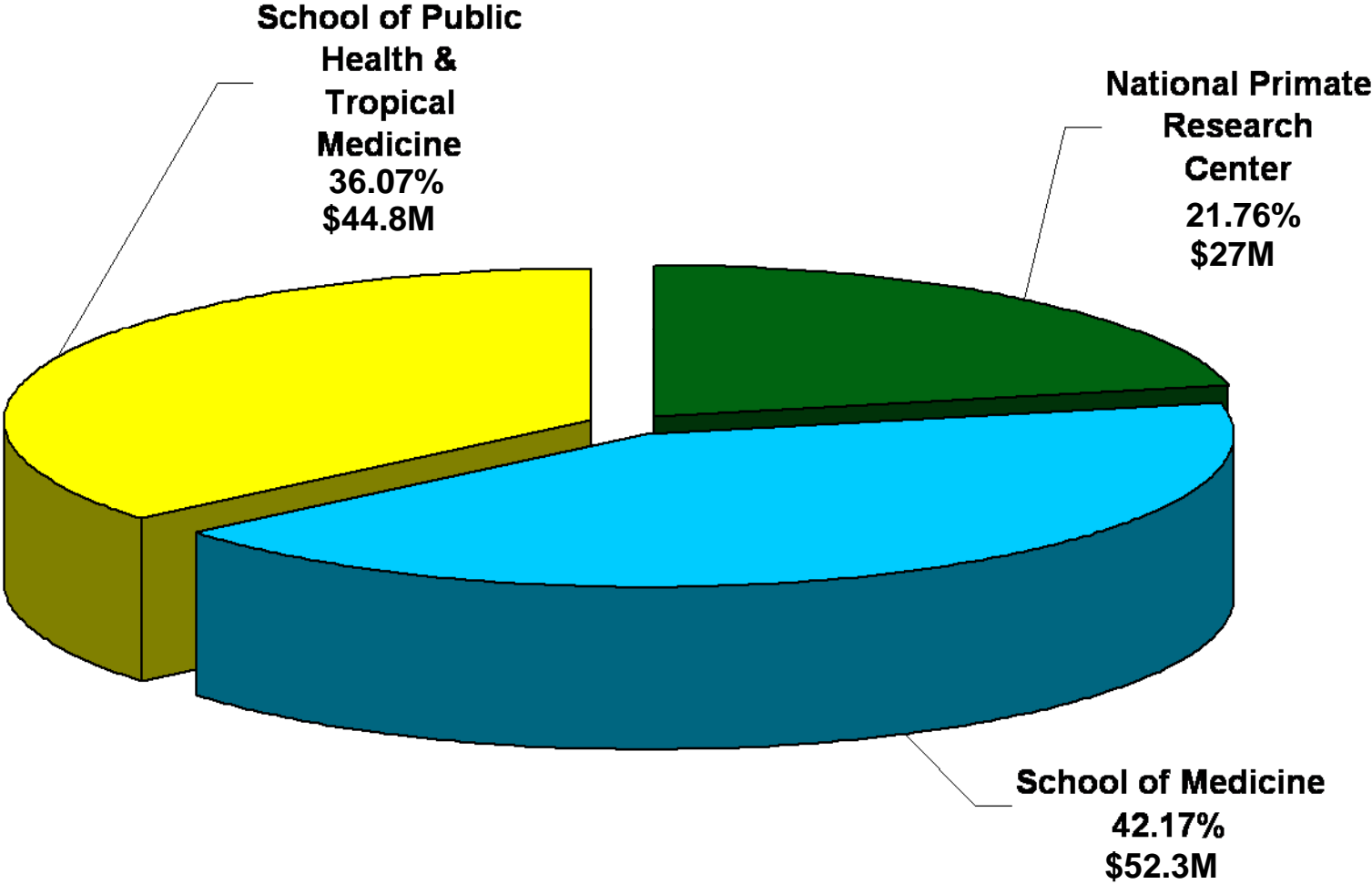


St. Charles Campus Sponsored Projects FY2007 Funding by School



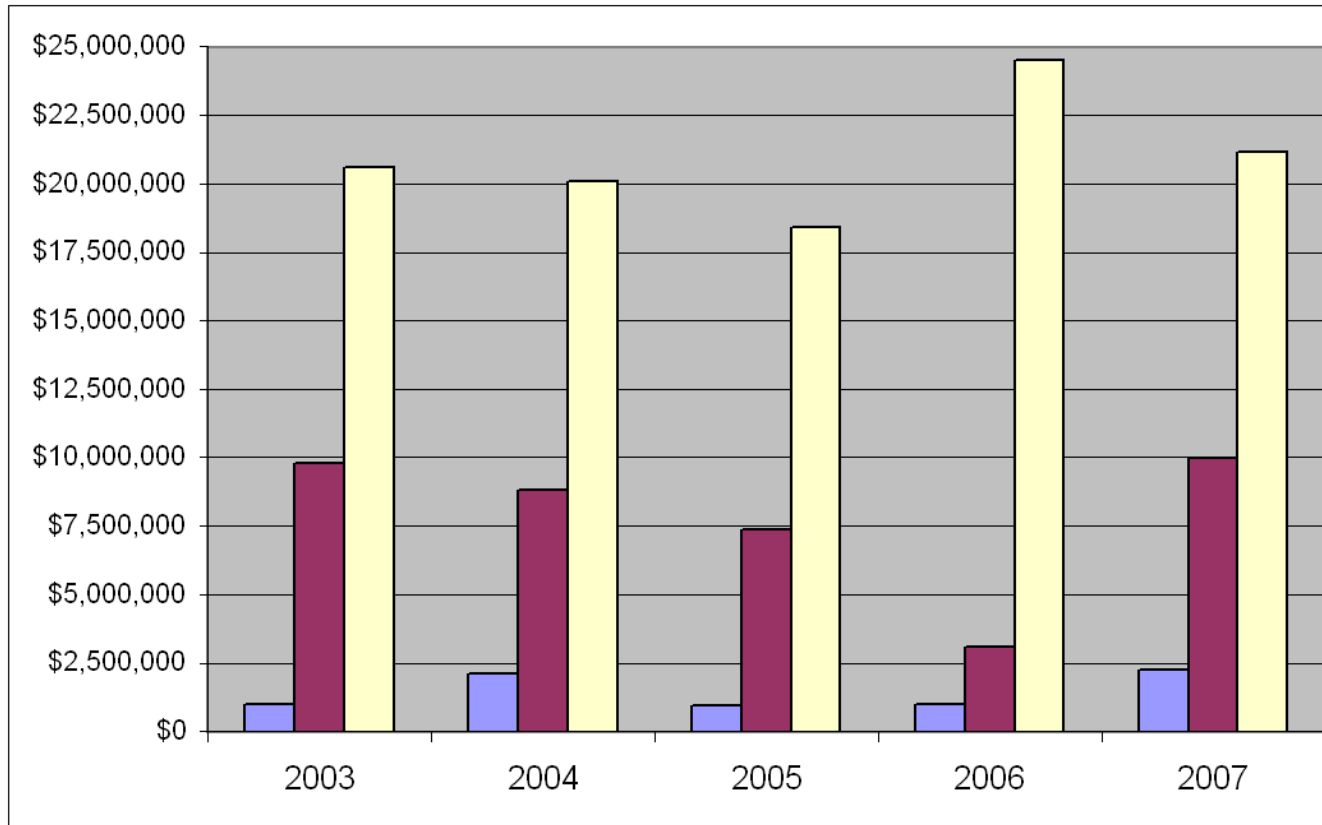




TU Health Sciences Center Sponsored Projects FY2007



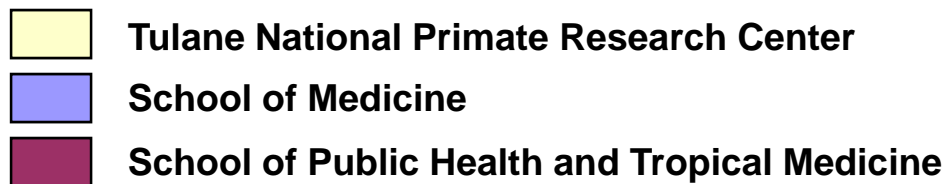
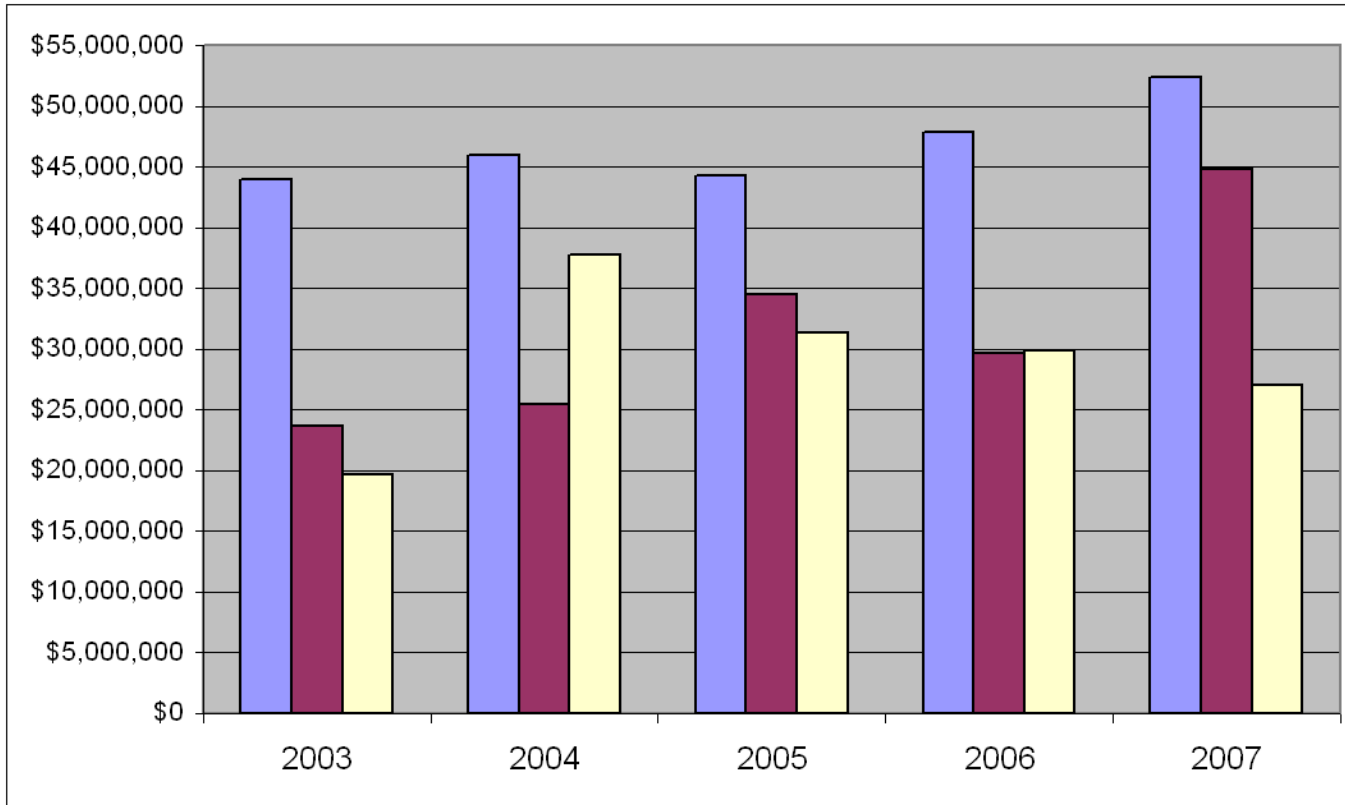

Tulane University Research Enhancement Fund

- **\$20M fund established April 2006.**
- **Objective is to support faculty initiatives in research, scholarship and creative endeavor university-wide.**
- **Phase I: \$7M distributed in June 2006 to reimburse investigators for salaries paid from grants during the evacuation period.**

- **Phase II: \$10M to be distributed competitively over four cycles.**
- **148 awards have been made totaling \$5M :**

Evidence-based decisions for investment in research

- **Valid, meaningful benchmarking is critical.**
- ***Academic Analytics* offers a Faculty Scholarly Productivity Index (FSP).**
- **FSP is a national ranking of each of our Ph.D. programs based on per capita faculty scholarly productivity.**
- **Overall, the 2005 FSP Index ranked Tulane 94th among 166 major research institutions.**
